We'll have more information by the April meeting, but the entry deadline is May 4th.

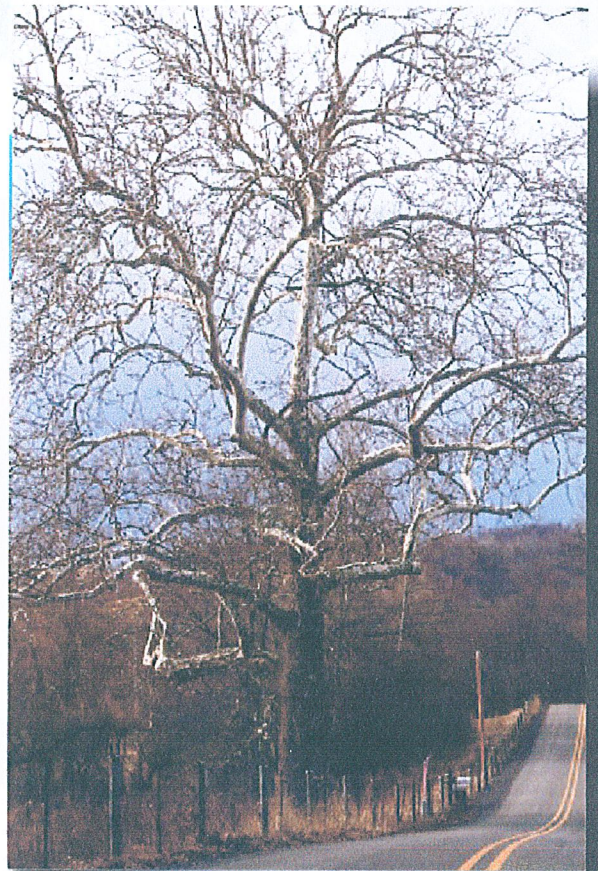
2007 Memorial Day Contest in Grafton, WV.
