The really big show for our club is the 2012 Sheep & Fiber Fest Exhibit/Contest. It is the most public event for our members to exhibit their work with almost a month of exhibition at the Pennsylvania Welcome Center from April 28-May 18 followed by the Sheep and Fiber Festival on the weekend of May 19th and 20th at the Greene County Fairground.

It is open to anyone with a camera who wants to enter (one photo per entrant), and the photo must be Spring Themed.
