September’s Photography Challenge is “Food”

Personally, I would rather eat food than take pictures of it! But this is certainly a great time to take pictures of vegetables, fresh fruit, cool drinks with condensation and ice cream.

Darlene Hildebrandt of Digital Photography School offers these tips:

1. Pick the freshest ingredients
2. Lighting is everything
3. Keep it simple
4. Use simple props including raw ingredients
5. Show a before and after shot
6. Show it cooking
7. Add a human element
8. Don’t cook it completely
9. Keep the plates clean
10. Vary your camera angle
11. Add a bit of oil to make it look fresher
