DPS Offers these tips for Capturing the Fall Colors:

1. Use a Polarising Filter
2. Shoot in the Golden Hours
3. Don’t ignore the Overcast Days
4. Look for Contrasts
5. Avoid Shooting Into the Sun
6. Play with White Balance Settings
7. Warm Up Filters (or use software)
8. Slightly Underexpose Your Shots
